Specific requirements

However complete a system, each local authority will have their own ways of doing things either due to different business processes or because of differing demands on their services due to demographics.

Some users might require a system that can be accessed via the internet by the property users, whilst others would prefer a highly advanced calendar function. There might be a requirement to advance GIS, whilst for others a higher level of security would be a must.

Agile Development

This development work would be completed using Agile methodologies, which has been effective form of software development.

It works by having the user fully test the existing system and based upon this experience they would draw up a list of the additional features and adaptations that they would require. Through close working with the Aligned Assets development team this list would be prioritised with those given the highest priority being built,

Whereas conventional development methods would rely on the user drawing developers to interpret, the two-way interaction in Agile of developer and user means that what is required is that which is actually built.

What is involved in an Agile development?

- The client constantly reviews what is produced and provides feedback.
- The client's decisions are made on use of the actual system and not on abstract
- A "production ready" deliverable is produced usually every 3 to 4 weeks for the client to test and comment on. This 3 to 4 weeks phase of development is called a sprint.
- User requirements are captured often in the form of user stories and are constantly re-prioritised by the client. The high priority ones are the ones that are tackled in next sprint.
- The client has the right to introduce new requirements or change existing ones throughout the project to cater for changing business requirements and also through their use of the actual software.
- The client has the right to change their mind on seeing what was previously requested.
- The important functionality is always built earliest possible ROI to the client.
